


San Gabriel Valley Cactus & Succulent Society Presentation "Soft Succulents" Jeff Moore, August 9, 2018

The talk will be titled Soft Succulents, which is also the title of the new book. The powerpoint/talk will follow the flow of the book, which is about all the soft, non-spiny succulents (well, not ALL, but representatives of each group). I'll show images and talk about aeoniums, echeverias, dudleyas, crassulas, sedums, senecios, kalanchoes, etc . I'll also touch a bit on landscaping and dish garden arrangements with them, as these are those types of plants, but the focus will be much more on the plants themselves than the arts and crafts with succulents thing. I'll take questions throughout or after the talk, and will bring plants and all 3 of my books to sell.
